^{*} It should be noted that the UN weighted exchange rate for the year 2007 (1 US\$ = 0,7328 Euro) has been applied in the calculation of the equivalent Euro amounts for all expenditure items that has been recorded and reported in US\$. Small gains and losses on exchange rate are incurred due to the use of such a conversion method.

BA Trust Fund Balance

The total balance of the General Trust Fund at the end of 2006, as certified by the Accounts Section, Budget and Financial Management Service of UNON, amount to 19,134 USD.

A certified balance of the General Trust Fund at the end of 2007 is not available yet. An increase in the balance is to be expected, corresponding to the unspent balance at the end of the 2007 financial year (approx. 41,781 Euro as per table 2 above), the one time payment to the Operating Reserve in 2007 (8,979 Euro), adjustments in relation to the 2005 accounts and any interest income.
