MID-TERM REPORT ON BUDGETARY ISSUES 2023

- 1. This report has been prepared using information provided by CMS Administrative and Finance Management Unit (AFMU).
- 2. The report contains figures as recorded in the enterprise resource planning system "Umoja" from 1 January to 30 June 2023. The report is presented in euro, after conversion from the US dollar figure reports generated by Umoja and cleared by AFMU. All euro figures are approximations due to variations in the exchange rate between Euro and US dollar. All figures are rounded to the next full Euro.
- 3. Voluntary contributions were received from:
 - Germany €25,600 for developing reports for the 11th Meeting of the North Sea Group and the 19th Meeting of the Jastarnia Group, supporting the long-term coordination of the harbour porpoise action plans, and for expert participation to AC28.
 - The Netherlands €10,000 for the scoping work of the strandings database, joint navies and NATO workshop, and coordination of the harbour porpoise conservation plans.
