- Ongoing bycatch mitigation trials of net reflectors in the southwest
- JCDP data holdings growing, work is ongoing to engage with other data providers and development of data products

- Marine Noise Registry has recently been developed and updated:
 - Two new functionalities

Disturbance Tool (assess the potential noise disturbance footprint)

Cooperation Tool (facilitates collaboration to resolve potential for noise exceeding limits)

- Strandings: live mass stranding of common dolphins (8 animals) in Cornwall in August 2023,7 refloated, one PME

Common dolphin: higher number of strandings seen in every month across England and Wales in 2023



Legislation updates



- Fisheries Act 2020 Joint Fisheries Statement; Fisheries Management Plans under development, current focus is harbour porpoise. Mandatory bycatch self-reporting introduced for all vessels
- Environment Act 2021 indicators under UKMS to be published in 2024, based heavily on OSPAR QSR, updated operational targets to reflect assessment outcomes
- Bycatch Mitigation Initiative (BMI) (August 2022) plans to develop the implementation plans over the coming months to deliver against the BMI objectives
- UK 'Cetacean Strategy' (working title) in development following consultation, aim for 2024 publication
- UK Habitat Regulations assessments (Habs Directive) methodologies may differ slightly but aiming to remain as consistent as possible (based on 2019 reporting).
