



3. Monitor and mitigate impact of underwater noise

Project "Renewal of the Program of Measures and Implementation of Measures to Achieve a Good State of the Baltic Sea Environment in Lithuania" - anthropogenic continuous underwater noise levels



Data registration: started 2022 March finished 2022 July

- Observed spectrum pressure level (SPL) values exceed the HELCOM noise expert group proposed limit levels for Harbour porpoise.
- Such sudden changes in SPL time series can be interpreted as anthropogenic noise events, primarily caused by shipping, that can trigger behavioral responses in marine mammals (avoidance).



4. Monitor and assess population health status

• Baltic Sea Animals Rehabilitation Center opened in 2022 October

• Established for seals health state assessment according to HELCOM recommendations:

- 1) monitor reproductive state
- 2) monitor blubber thickness


