

Getting to Zandvoort

Zandvoort has a train station, Zandvoort aan Zee, with half-hourly services to Haarlem and Amsterdam. Participants arriving at Amsterdam Schiphol airport (AMS) or Amsterdam Central train station can reach Zandvoort by train, taxi or bus. The best way to get to Zandvoort without a car is the train (going every 30 minutes) which takes about an hour and costs start from €8.70 one way (depending on the train you choose). Below, you can find an example travel. It is not necessary to buy a physical train ticket, since you can use your debit card or credit card to "check in" at the train station. To plan your trip from the Airport or Amsterdam Centraal to Zandvoort, visit: https://www.ns.nl/en. Otherwise, there are metered taxis in the airport. Also, Uber service is available.

- 12th Meeting of the North Sea Group (NSG12): start at 09:00 CET on Tuesday 12 March, end at 18:00 CET on Wednesday 13 March.
- 20th Meeting of the Jastarnia Group (JG20): start at 14:00 on Wednesday 13 March, end at 13:00 on Friday 15 March.
- Joint session of the NSG and JG will be held on Wednesday 13 March from 14:00 to 18:00 CET.

Venue

The meeting will take place at **Thalassa Beach**, Boulevard Barnaart, Strandafgang 18, 2041 KB Zandvoort, https://thalassabeach.nl/events/. The meeting room will be signposted. The venue is a 5-minute walk from the train station Zandvoort aan Zee.



Registration

Registration is open online (NSG12, JG20) until 11 February 2024. Those who have registered online can sign in at the meeting venue to pick up their meeting badges at one of these times:

- Tuesday 12 March at 08:30-09:00 CET
- Wednesday 13 March at 13:30-14:00 CET
- Thursday 14 March at 08:30-09:00 CET.

Please wear the meeting badge throughout the duration of the meeting. The plastic pocket can be returned to the Secretariat staff at the end of the meeting.
