Aims and scope

The overall aim of the project is for scientists, fishers, authorities and other relevant stakeholders to work together to minimise - and, where possible, eliminate – incidental bycatch of priority Endangered, Threatened and Protected (ETP) marine species:

- Especially priority marine mammals, birds, turtles and elasmobranchs
- In high-risk fisheries (gillnets, longlines, bottom and pelagic trawls)
- In the NEA, Baltic and Mediterranean







- More selective fishery

WP 8 monitoring the project and its impact: Theory of change

Expected impacts:

- ➤ Increased collaboration between fishers, fisher organisations, scientists, NGOs and government organisations to quantify and mitigate bycatch of ETP species
- Reduction in bycatch of ETP species due to a better mitigation framework adopted across EU
- ➤ Now ~ 80 indicators, try to decrease!
